Please note that we are also looking for volunteers to **start at ISCA in September 2020 for a period of 12 months**, and your application may be considered for a role at that time.

In addition, the applicants should join the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) platform and indicate their "Participant reference number" in the body of the e-mail when applying. This only applies if you are a legal resident in, or have the nationality of one of the European Union Member States, or of the following countries: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.
