Project Place

The Project will take place in Athens city the capital of Greece.





The name of **Athens**, connected to the name of its patron goddess Athena, originates from an earlier random city-state, Greek Pre Greek language.

The etiological explaining how Athens acquired this name through the legendary contest between Poseidon and Athena was described by Herodotus, Apollodorus, Ovid, Plutarch, Pausanias and others.

It even became the theme of the sculpture on the West pediment of the Parthenon. Both Athena and Poseidon requested to be patrons of the city and to give their name to it, so they competed with one another for the honour, offering the city one gift each. Poseidon produced a spring by striking the ground with his trident, symbolizing naval power.





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Athena created the olive tree, symbolizing peace and prosperity. The Athenians, under their ruler Cecrops, accepted the olive tree and named the city after Athena.

A sacred olive tree said to be the one created by the goddess was still kept on the Acropolis at the time of Pausanias (2nd century AD).

It was located by the temple of Pandrosus, next to the Parthenon. According to Herodotus, the tree had been burnt

down during the Persian Wars, but a shoot sprung from the stump. To the Greeks they saw this as a symbol that Athena still had her mark there on the city.

ACCOMODATION AND FOOD

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants are expected to arrive in Athens on **14th of April 2024** after **12.00 p.m.** (check in) and check out on **20th of April 2024** after **12.00 p.m.** Organizers will **NOT** provide any accommodation further of the days of the project.

EUROPEAN HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

All participants need to have with them the European Health Insurance Card, which is necessary for your stay in Athens.

As our organisation cannot cover any issues related to health insurance or medical access please apply for the card in your country or check the expiring date in case you already have one. Also, in case of medication that you may use during your stay it is important to have with you doctor's prescription and your medicine as well. ARRIVING IN ATHENS AIRPORT

All participants that are arriving in Athens Airport there is connection with Bus so you can use directly to arrive in the Hotel where the project will take place .

The cost of the Bus ticket from Airport to the Hotel is **6 euros** , so please keep with you the ticket and the receipt of buying from the machines in the station .
